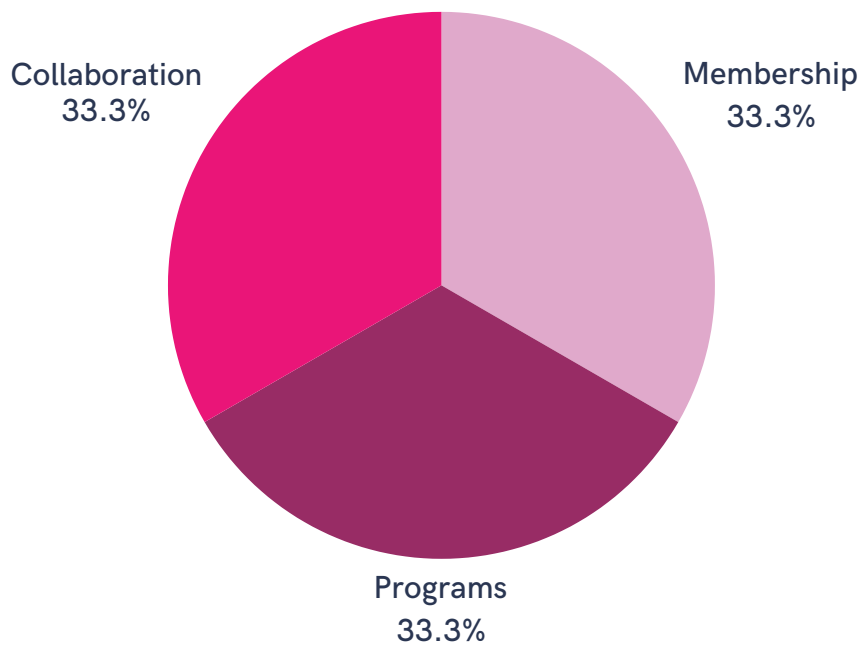

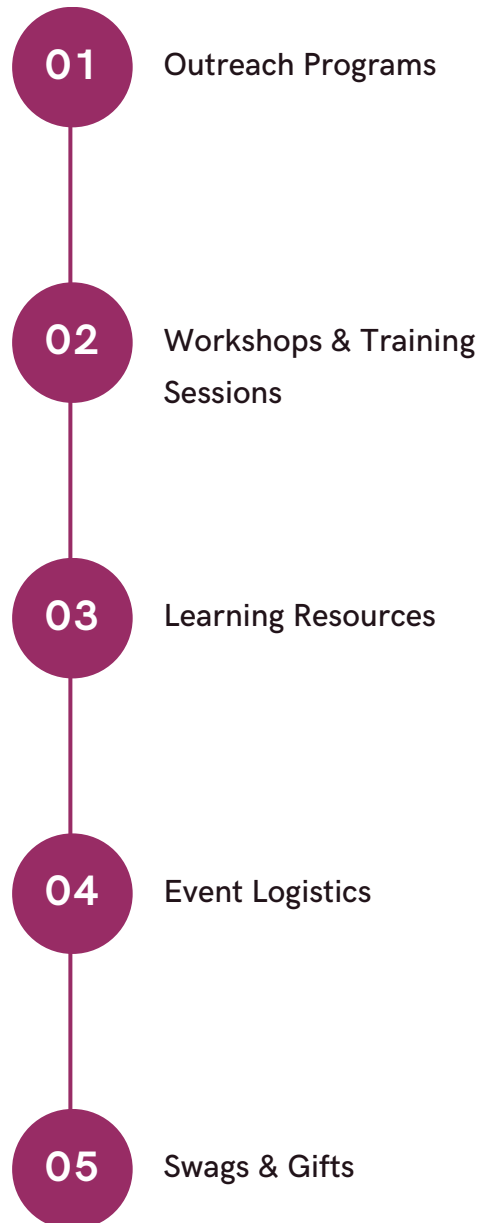
Identify and connect with women and girls in underserved areas across Abeokuta.
